9. BYLAWS 2023-030: Actual Cost Levy re Smeltzer Drain

WHEREAS Council has been presented with Bylaw 2023–030 being a Bylaw to amend By-Law 2020-011 and provide for the actual cost levy of the Smeltzer Drain 2020 in the Township of Tehkummah;

- that the actual total cost of the Smeltzer Drain 2020 shall be levied to the assessed lands and roads in accordance with the provisions of the Engineer's report in Bylaw 2020-011 which adopted the report;
- 2. that the actual cost levied shall be reduced by the amount of grant received under Section 85 of the Act and by the amount of allowances granted under the Act in accordance with Section 62(3) of the Act;
- 3. that the actual cost to be levied shall be as outlined in Schedule C attached and the amounts shown in Schedule C;
- 4. that amounts owing up to \$1,000 have up to six (6) months from the billing date for payment; amounts owing between \$1,001 and \$2,500 have up to one (1) year from the billing date for payment; amounts owing between \$,2501 and \$5,000 have up to two (2) years from the billing date for payment; amounts owing between \$5,001 and \$7,500 have up to three (3) years from the billing date for payment; and amounts owing over \$7,501 have up to four (4) years from the billing date for payment; provided that a payment is made in each year of a portion of the outstanding amount.
- 5. that this Bylaw shall come into force and effect as on the date of enactment and may be cited as the "Smeltzer Drain 2020 Final Cost Levy Bylaw".
