Amended Declaration of Emergency

I, Steven Wood, Deputy Mayor of Tehkummah Township, Ontario hereby declare an Emergency in accordance with the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.9, s.4. (1) Due to the emergency described herein

For the Emergency Area or part thereof described as:

Significant flooding of Manitou River at Michael's Bay Road and Pennie Avenue with road washout and some homes in peril. Water levels will soon increase due to MNR lifting the dam at Lake Manitou in Sandfield in a matter of days. Evacuations in process, with some residents refusing to be relocated at this time.

AMENDED April 14, 2026 6:13 pm

Because of continuing higher water levels, the area affected has extended from Townline Road and 15th Concession intersection to Michael's Bay Road as well as the Blue Jay Creek area from 10th Sideroad to 6th Concession west.
